Available position

NASR is edited by a committee of four editors (MA/PhD students), an editor-in-chief (PhD student), and an academic coordinator (senior academic). We are currently looking for a new editor-in-chief to lead the editorial committee from 1 September 2022 onwards. As editor-in-chief, you will be responsible for the publication of each issue. Tasks include organizing meetings, selecting papers for publication, editing papers, and coordinating a team of four student editors. You will also serve as a PhD Representative in the NASA board and keep the board up-to-date on the journal. The editor-in-chief works on a voluntary basis and can expect to spend approximately fifty hours on each issue, most of which will be done in the months of April/May (Spring issue) and October/November (Fall issue).

Requirements

- You are a **PhD student in American Studies** or a related field at a **Dutch university**
- You have an **excellent command of the English** language and are familiar with the basic rules of academic writing
- Some **editorial experience** is a plus, but not a requirement
